- 16** individual mandates accepted
Last one = M/500 on Fans (March 2012)
- 7** references sent to EC since Jan. 2012
- 8** standards in development
- ± 3** standards yet to be started

(II)



- Work rather smooth
- Linear process:

IR → specific mandate → standards work

- **BUT** little involvement of TC until IR was published

Already a few WIs in development

- Published in OJ under IRs

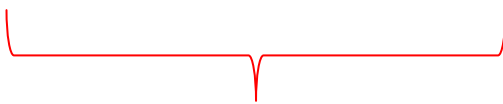
Systematic TC involvement from the start of preparatory study

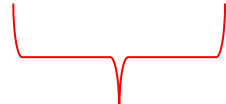

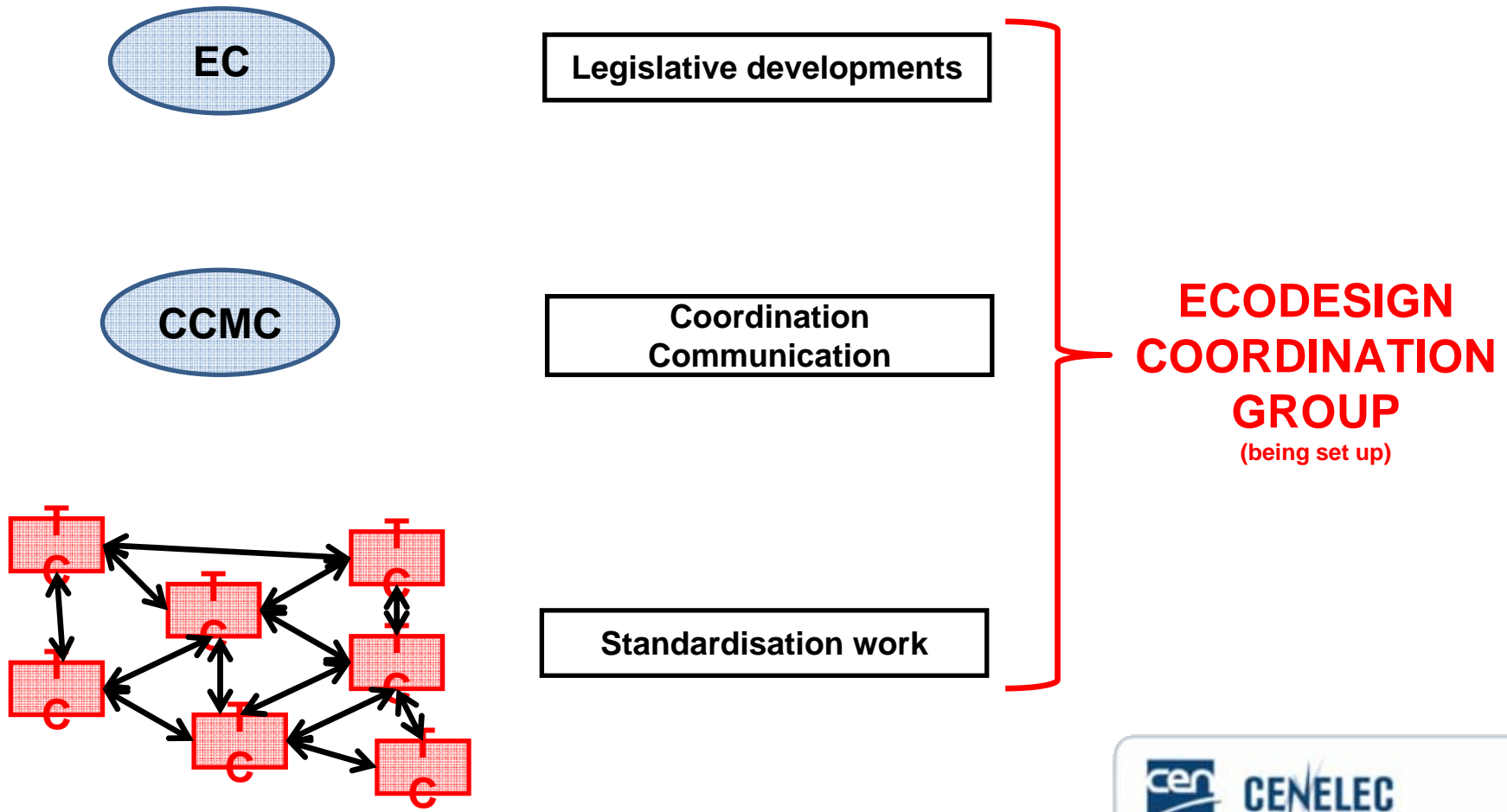
Challenge:

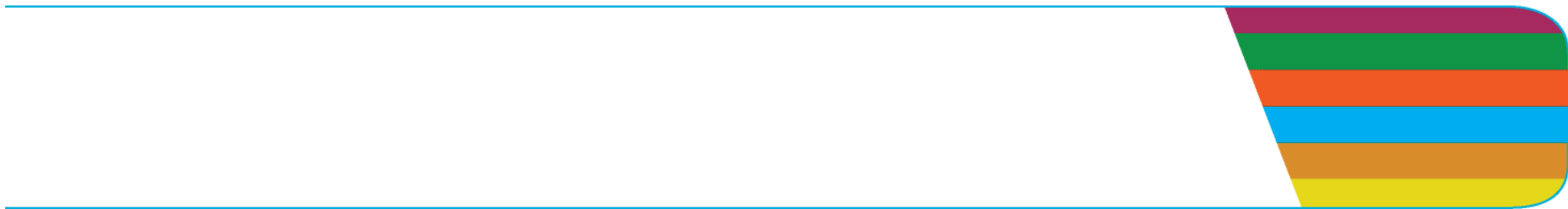
- 23 product groups
